THIS UNIT'S COLOR IS THE TRADEMARK OF THE BATTALION, ITS UNIQUE SYMBOLS AND COLORS HAD ITS RESPECTIVE MEANING AS FOLLOWS.

SHIELD – REPRESENT THE MILITARY'S TRADITIONAL ROLE, THAT OF A PROTECTOR OF PEOPLE AND THE STATE.

BLACK AND WHITE – DESCRIBE EXTREME CONDITIONS, THAT THE FOOT SOLDIER IS TRAINED TO OPERATE IN DAY AND NIGHT, RAIN OR SHINE, HOT OR COLD, MOUNTAINOUS OR FLAT TERRAIN ETC.

OCTAGON – FOR LUCK, THE BATTALION WAS BORN IN THE LUCKY YEAR OF THE DRAGON, WHERE 8 IS KING.

COUGAR – A MEMBER OF CAT'S FAMILY, THE FAVORITE MASCOTS OF FOOT SOLDIERS, WITH A GOOD REASON, THEY MOVE SWIFTLY, SILENTLY AND FEROCIOUSLY. THE SAME IDEALS OF THE INFANTRY.

GREEN & GOLD – AS DOMINANT COLORS, THEY REPRESENT THE TERRAIN SUITED FOR INFANTRY OPERATION: FOLIAGE OF GREEN AND GOLDEN FRUITS/SEEDS. LIKEWISE, IT PICTURES THE PHASES IN A STRUGGLE: GREEN FOR HOPE AND GOLD FOR SUCCESS.

WE DARE – THE TROOPER'S SLOGAN, IT IS A COMMITMENT; WE DARE TAKE ON BOTH FAMILIAR AND UNFAMILIAR TASKS. THE SOLDIER'S DARE TO DO WHAT IS CALLED UPON HIM BY HIS MILITARY PROFESSION.

UNIT HISTORY

PURSUANT TO GENERAL ORDER NUMBER 222 HEADQUARTERS PHILIPPINE ARMY DATED 02 MAY 1988, THE 69TH INFANTRY (COUGAR) BATTALION WAS ACTIVATED, ORGANIZED, TRAINED AND EQUIPPED IN FORT BONIFACIO, METRO MANILA AS ONE OF THE UNITS OF THE PHILIPPINE ARMY EFFECTIVE 16 APRIL 1988.

ON 16 APR 88, MAJOR ANTONIO S YRREVERRE (INF) PA WAS DESIGNATED AS OFFICER-IN-CHARGE PURPOSELY FOR THE ORGANIZATION AND TRAINING OF THE UNIT AND ITS PERSONNEL. THE ORGANIZATION AND FILL-UP OF THREE (3) RIFLE COMPANIES AND SERVICE COMPANY WAS COMPLETED ON 09 OCTOBER 1988.

WHEN LTC ROMEO B DOMINGUEZ 0-5861 (INF) PA ASSUMED COMMAND ON 01 OCT 88, THE BATTALION WAS MOVED FROM FORT BONIFACIO, METRO MANILA TO FORT MAGSAYSAY, PALAYAN CITY TO UNDERGO BATTALION TRAINING. AS PART OF ITS TRAINING, THE BATTALION PARTICIPATED IN THE RP-US BADGE PACK/BALIKATAN 88-89 WITH THE US ARMY SPECIAL FORCES FROM 01 JUNE TO 19 NOVEMBER 1988. THE UNIT WAS FURTHER REFURBISHED WHEN LIEUTENANT COLONEL DOMINGUEZ WEEDED OUT MISFITS AND UNDESIRABLES FROM ITS ASSIGNED PERSONNEL.

EVENTUALLY, THE BATTALION BECAME A MAJOR SUBORDINATE UNIT OF 7TH INFANTRY DIVISION (ERSTWHILE 3RD INFANTRY BRIGADE (SEP), PA) EFFECTIVE 16 AUGUST 1989. ITS MAIDEN FIELD ASSIGNMENT WAS AT BRGY LIYANG, PILAR, BATAAN ON 20 JANUARY 1989 AND WAS MOVED TO BRGY CUTCUT, ANGELES CITY ON 01 JUNE 1989. ON JANUARY 1990, THE BATTALION WAS MOVED TO BRGY MALIWALO, BACOLOR, PAMPANGA AND FURTHER DISPLACED TO BRGY BAYAN-BAYANAN, DINALUPIHAN, BATAAN ON 25 APRIL 1990.

ON 15 AUG 90, MAJ DANIEL J GALIA 0-6547 (INF) PA ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE UNIT AND THE BATTALION'S AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (AOR) WAS EXTENDED TO BATAAN AND ZAMBALES ON 15 SEPTEMBER 1991. DURING THE INCUMBENCY OF MAJ DOMINADOR C TAGORDA JR 0-7077 (INF) PA, WHO ASSUMED COMMAND ON 16 AUG 91. THE BATTALION CONSOLIDATED AT BRGY

INHOBOL, MASINLOC, ZAMBALES WHILE WAITING FOR ORDERS TO SHIFT ITS COIN MISSION IN THE MOUNTAIN PROVINCE.

AFTER ALMOST A MONTH, THE UNIT FINALLY MOVED TO ITS NEW AOR AT THE MOUNTAIN PROVINCE AND PURSUED ITS COUNTER-INSURGENCY MISSION AS WELL AS CONTROL OF THE DETERIORATING PEACE AND ORDER SITUATION IN THE PROVINCE DUE TO EXISTENCE OF COMMUNIST TERRORISTS.

THE BATTALION ESTABLISHED IT'S HEADQUARTERS AT MARDOMUS HILL, TADIAN, MT PROVINCE ON 23 OCTOBER 1991. AFTER THE TRAGIC DEATH OF LATE MAJOR DOMINADOR C TAGORDA JR, THE BATTALION COMMANDER TOGETHER WITH THIRTEEN (13) ENLISTED PERSONNEL WHO WERE TREACHEROUSLY AMBUSHED BY COMMUNIST TERRORISTS ON 08 JANUARY 1992 AT BRGY SADSADAN, BAUKO, MT PROVINCE, MAJ ROMULO PARICA 0-104271 (FA) PA ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE UNIT AND THE BATTALION HQS WAS STRATEGICALLY RELOCATED TO LALLALAY, SAGADA, MT PROVINCE ON 01 APRIL 1992. ON 05 SEPTEMBER 1992, THE BATTALION HQS WAS CO-LOCATED WITH MT PROVINCE PROVINCIAL POLICE COMMAND (MPPC).

ON 16 OCT 92, MAJ PAULO P PAGTEILAN 0-104248 (INF) PA ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE UNIT AND MOVED TO ESTABLISH BATTALION HQS AT SITIO BANSA, BRGY MONAMON NORTE, BAUKO, MT PROVINCE ON 30 NOVEMBER 1992. THE BATTALION LEFT THE AREA AND RE-ESTABLISHED ITS BASE IN ABATAN JUNCTION, BAUKO, MT PROVINCE ON 15 JANUARY 1993. UPON THE EXPANSION OF BATTALION'S AOR DUE TO THE INCLUSION OF BENGUET PROVINCE AS PART OF THE AOR ON 20 MARCH 1994, THE HEADQUARTERS OF 69IB MOVED TO BRGY LEPANTO, MANKAYAN, BENGUET.

AFTER ACCOMPLISHING ITS NOBLE MISSION IN THE AREA, THE BATTALION HQS WAS AGAIN MOVED AND CO-LOCATED WITH PNP MOBILE GROUP AT CAMP MOLINTAS, BRGY ABATAN, BUGUIAS, BENGUET ON 25 APRIL 1994. HIGHER HEADQUARTERS DIRECTED THE UNIT TO LEAVE MOUNTAIN PROVINCE AND BENGUET ON 18 JULY 1994 TO UNDERGO BATTALION RETRAINING AT FORT MAGSAYSAY, PALAYAN CITY ON 10 NOVEMBER 1994.

ON 12 NOV 94, COL WILLY A ANDRES 0-5543 INF (GSC) PA ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE UNIT AND BROUGHT THE BATTALION TO RELIEVE IN PLACE 72ND INFANTRY BATTALION STATIONED AT BRGY DILONG, TUBO, ABRA WHICH WAS SCHEDULED TO UNDERGO BN RETRAINING. COL ANDES WAS REPLACED BY COL GODOFREDO C MELAD O-101297 INF (GSC) PA ON 28 MAY 95.

DUE TO THE INCLUSION OF MT PROVINCE TO BE PART IN THE UNIT'S AOR, THE UNIT MOVED FROM BRGY APAPAYA, VILLAVICIOSA, ABRA TO DAPDAPANAN, SAGADA, MT PROVINCE ON 15 SEPTEMBER 1995 UPON REQUEST OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT.

LTC MANUEL S MARCON JR 0-7089 (INF) PA ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE UNIT ON 05 FEB 96 AND RELINQUISHED RESPONSIBILITY OF DAPDAPANAN, SAGADA, MT PROVINCE ON 07 APRIL 1997 TO 5TH INFANTRY DIVISION IN MT PROVINCE TO FOCUS AND CONCENTRATE IN THE PROVINCE OF ABRA. THE FORMER HEADQUARTERS OF 701ST INFANTRY BRIGADE AT BRGY GADDANI, TAYUM, ABRA WAS SELECTED AS THE BATTALION HQS TO EFFECTIVELY SUPERVISE THE WHOLE PROVINCE OF ABRA AND SOUTHERN ILOCOS SUR.

AFTER A STINT OF ONE (1) YEAR AND FIVE (5) MONTHS IN SAID AREA, THE UNIT WHICH WAS THEN UNDER LTC ROMMEL A GOMEZ 0-7785 (INF) PA, WHO ASSUMED COMMAND ON 01 OCT 97, WAS ORDERED BY HIGHER HEADQUARTERS TO RELINQUISH IT'S AOR TO 17TH INFANTRY (DO OR DIE) BATTALION, 5TH INFANTRY DIVISION, PHILIPPINE ARMY AND CONTINUED ITS COUNTER-INSURGENCY MISSION TO FACE THE GROWING THREATS OF CTS IN CENTRAL LUZON.

ON 26 MAR 98, LTC REMEGIO M DE VERA 0-8540 (FA) PA ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE UNIT AND ON 11 SEPTEMBER 1998, THE BATTALION MOVED FROM ABRA TO COVER THE TWO PROVINCES IN CENTRAL LUZON NAMELY; TARLAC AND PAMPANGA AND ESTABLISHED ITS HQS AT BRGY BURGOS, SAN JOSE, TARLAC. THE BATTALION WAS DIRECTED TO UNDERGO UNIT RETRAINING AT HEADQUARTERS NORTHERN LUZON COMMAND CAMP AQUINO, SAN MIGUEL, TARLAC CITY AND TEMPORARILY ESTABLISHED BN HQS THEREAT.

AFTER THE UNIT TRAINING, THE BATTALION MOVED ITS HEADQUARTERS TO BRGY IBA, SAN JOSE, TARLAC ON 01 MAY 1999 AND

AFTER SERIES OF HEAVY RAIN DOWNPOUR IN THE MIDDLE OF JUNE AND JULY SAME YEAR, THE NEWLY ESTABLISHED COMMAND POST WAS STRUCK BY FLOODS AND EROSIONS PROMPTING THE UNIT TO VACATE THE AREA AND TEMPORARILY ESTABLISHED ITS HEADQUARTERS AT CAMP AQUINO ON 30 JULY 1999 THEN MOVED TO BRGY MORIONES, SAN JOSE, TARLAC ON 15 SEPTEMBER 1999. THE BATTALION AGAIN MOVED ITS HEADQUARTERS AT BRGY JEFMIN, CONCEPCION, TARLAC ON 01 MARCH 2000. ON MAY 2000, SIX (6) TOWNS OF WESTERN PANGASINAN AND THE WHOLE OF CENTRAL PANGASINAN WERE ALSO ADDED AS OUR AREA OF OPERATION. ON 15 JUNE 2000, THE BATTALION MOVED FURTHER TO BRGY BURGOS, SAN JOSE, TARLAC TO OCCUPY THE VACATED HEADQUARTERS OF 703RD INFANTRY (AGILA) BRIGADE.

ON 24 OCT 00, COL GERARDO LAYUG 0-8113 CAV (GSC) PA ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE UNIT. THE UNIT AGAIN MOVED TO HQS NOLCOM FOR CONSOLIDATION OF ITS BN HQS AND HQS & HQS SVC COY TO PAVE THE WAY FOR THE RETURN OF 703RD INFANTRY BRIGADE FROM DAVAO ON 18 APRIL 2001 AND FROM THEN ON HEADQUARTERS 69IB FOUND ITS NEW BATTALION HQS AT SITIO PANAIAN, BRGY SAN NICOLAS, BAMBAN, TARLAC ON 20 SEPTEMBER 2001. ON 25 JANUARY 2003, WESTERN AND CENTRAL PANGASINAN AREA WAS TURNED OVER TO 24TH INFANTRY BATTALION AND 71ST INFANTRY BATTALION.

ON 01 MAR 04, COL RICARDO R VISAYA 0-8773 INF (GSC) PA ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE UNIT AND BROUGHT THE BATTALION TO ESTABLISH ITS NEW BATTALION COMMAND POST (CP) AT BRGY SAN JOSE MATULID, MEXICO, PAMPANGA ON 31 OCTOBER 2005. THE UNIT COVERED THE AREA OF OPERATION (AO) IN SOUTHEASTERN PAMPANGA, THE MUNICIPALITIES OF BAMBAN AND CONCEPCION BOTH OF TARLAC PROVINCE AND THE MUNICIPALITY OF CABIAO, NUEVA ECIJA.

ON 30 SEP 06, LTC EDISON V CAGA 0-9287 INF (GSC) PA ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE UNIT AND RELOCATED THE BATTALION HQS TO BRGY UPPER BIGTE, NORZAGARAY, BULACAN ON 01 DECEMBER 2006 TO TEMPORARY REPLACE 56IB AT BRGY TARTARO, SAN MIGUEL, BULACAN, WHICH WAS SCHEDULED TO UNDERGO BATTALION RE-TRAINING. EASTERN BULACAN THEN BECAME PART OF THE BATTALION'S AREA OF OPERATION (AO). ON 07 MARCH 2007, AFTER THE RE-TRAINING OF 56IB THE BATTALION

(69IB), THE UNIT SHIFTED BACK TO BRGY SAN JOSE MATULID, MEXICO, PAMPANGA AND AFTER ONE (1) MONTH, THE BATTALION MOVED BACK TO FORMER BN BASE IN SITIO PANAIAN, BRGY SAN NICOLAS, BAMBAN, TARLAC TO RESUME ITS MISSION IN THE AREA OF OPERATION (AO).

ON 01 JULY 2007, 1ST QUARTERING PARTY OF THE COUGAR BATTALION RELIEVED IN REPLACED 48IB IN THEIR AO IN AURORA, PROVINCE – ONE (1) MUNICIPALITY IN ISABELA (DINAPIGUE) AND ONE (1) MUNICIPALITY OF NUEVA VIZCAYA PROVINCE (ALFONSO CASTANEDA). ON 10 JULY 2007, THE 2ND QUARTERING PARTY OF THE BATTALION OCCUPIED THE EIGHT (8) MUNICIPALITIES OF EASTERN NUEVA ECIJA INCLUDING TWO (2) CITIES TO CONTINUE ITS ISO MISSION.

AFTER THE RE-TRAINING OF 48IB, THE BATTALION WAS RELIEVED IN PLACE BY 48IB AND MOVED TO FORT MAGSAYSAY PALAYAN CITY ON 27 JUNE 08 TO UNDERGO BATTALION RE-TRAINING. THE SCHEDULED RETRAINING OF THE BATTALION DID NOT MATERIALIZED DUE TO THE PREVAILING SITUATION IN NORTH COTABATO.

LTC CESAR D DE MESA 0-9952 INF (GSC) PA ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE UNIT ON 05 JUL 08 AND BROUGHT THE BATTALION TO HEADQUARTERS 6TH INFANTRY DIVISION, PA, CAMP SIONGCO AWANG, DOS, SHARIFF KABUNSUAN ON 12 AUGUST 2008. THE UNIT WAS PLACED OPCON TO 602ND BRIGADE ON 15 AUGUST 2008 AND ESTABLISHED ITS HEADQUARTERS AT BRGY NICAAN, LIBUNGAN, NORTH COTABATO COVERING THE MUNICIPALITIES OF ALAMADA AND BANISILAN.

DURING THE STAY OF THE BATTALION ON THE MUNICIPALITIES OF BANISILAN, ALAMADA AND BRGY NICAAN, LIBUNGAN, NORTH COTABATO, EFFORTS TOWARDS ATTAINING THE LASTING PEACE ON THE SAID AREA WAS THE MAIN CONCERN. THE BARANGAY OFFICIALS IN BOTH MUNICIPALITIES WERE ENCOURAGED AND MOBILIZED TO INITIATE ACTIONS IN ESTABLISHING THE BARANGAY DEFENSE SYSTEM. DURING THE TIME, CHARLIE COMPANY WAS DESIGNATED AS FIRST BN READY DEPLOYMENT FORCE DEPLOYED TO CONDUCT OPERATIONS AT BULIOK COMPLEX.

ON 02 DECEMBER 2008 THE BATTALION RELIEVED IN PLACE 28IB, 10ID TO COVER THE MUNICIPALITIES OF KABACAN, MATALAM, M'LANG ALL OF

NORTH COTABATO. MEANWHILE, ALPHA COMPANY WAS DESIGNATED AS 2ND BN READY DEPLOYMENT FORCE WAS PLACED OPCON WITH 601ST BRIGADE, 6ID, PA IN MAGUINDANAO AREA TO SUSTAIN ISO MISSION AGAINST SPSG, ATG/L AND FTO'S IN THE AREA.

ON 03 JANUARY 2009 THE MEDICAL AND DENTAL MISSION WAS CONDUCTED INSIDE THE BATTALION HEADQUARTERS THROUGH THE EFFORT OF THE BATTALION AND HON GOVERNOR JESUS V SACDALAN BENEFITING BOTH MUSLIM AND CHRISTIAN COMMUNITIES SURROUNDING THE BATTALION HEADQUARTERS. THIS WAS PATTERNED IN THE BN'S CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION IN 2008 WHEN IT INVITED APPROXIMATELY **300** CHILDREN FROM THE NEIGHBORING BARANGAYS, ONE OF THE REMARKABLE MILESTONES TOWARDS GAINING BACK THE TRUST AND CONFIDENCE OF THE POPULACE TO THE ARMY AND THE GOVERNMENT AS A WHOLE.

IN MAY 2009, BRAVO COMPANY BECAME THE THIRD BN READY DEPLOYMENT FORCE PLACED OPCON WITH 601ST BDE, 6ID THAT OPERATED IN GUINDALUNGAN MAGUINDANAO.

THE UNIT CONTRIBUTED TO THE 6ID ACCOMPLISHMENT WITH THE CAPTURE OF MILF CAMP AFGHAN IN GUINDALUNGAN, MAGUINDANAO AND KILLED 12-LMGs, 1-LMG APPREHENDED, RECOVERED 1-RPG, 1-M79, 1-M14, 3-IEDs, 2-60MM MORTAR AND 2-B40 AMMO.

ON 01 AUGUST 2009, PEACE TALK BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT PANEL AND THE LAWLESS MILF GROUPS RESUMED, THAT BROUGHT THE BATTALION TO BE PLACED OPCON WITH 10TH INFANTRY DIVISION, PA CAMP PANACAN, DAVAO CITY ON 10 AUGUST 2009 TO SUSTAIN ITS ISO MISSION AGAINST CPP/NDF/NPA IN THE AREA. THE UNIT WAS THEN PLACED OPCON TO 1003RD BRIDAGE, 10ID, PA AND ESTABLISHED ITS TEMPORARY HEADQUARTERS AT BRGY DALISAY, PANABO CITY, DAVAO DEL NORTE COVERING TWO (2) CITIES OF DAVAO AND PANABO AND THREE (3) MUNICIPALITIES OF CARMEN, DUJALI AND STO TOMAS.

DURING THE STAY OF THE BATTALION IN PANABO CITY, SEVERAL EFFORTS WERE CONDUCTED TO ATTAIN PEACE IN THE AREA SUCH AS SYMPOSIUM/ DIALOGUE TO BARANGAYS AND A SERIES OF MEDICAL AND DENTAL MISSION ALLONG THE 40 BARANGAY'S OF PANABO CITY.

ON 04 DECEMBER 2009, THE BATTALION MOVED TO DAVAO CITY AND ESTABLISHED ITS HEADQUARTERS AT BRGY MANDUG, BUHANGIN DISTRICT, DAVAO CITY. IN ORDER EFFECTIVELY CONTROL AND SUPERVISE THE THREE (3) ORGANIC COMPANIES AND SECURE DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN DAVAO CITY.

THE UNIT AGAIN PROVED ITS CAPABILITIES AND EXCEPTIONAL PERFORMANCE OF DUTY THAT CONTRIBUTED TO 10ID ACCOMPLISHMENTS BY RECOVERING FOUR (4) CTS BODY COUNTS, ONE (1) 90RR, FIVE (5) M16 RIFLES, ONE (1) M1 CARBINE, TWELVE (12) IMPROVISED EXPLOSIVE DEVICES AND SUBVERSIVE DOCUMENTS FROM THE CTS. FURTHERMORE, SEVERAL EFFORTS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED BY THIS UNIT SUCH AS MEDCAPS, SYMPOSIUM TO STUDENTS, CLEANLINESS DRIVES, DIALOGUES TO LGUS AND NGOS, TREE PLANTING AND FEEDING PROGRAMS. THE UNIT ALSO CONDUCTED SECURITY OPERATIONS IN THE WHOLE AO PARTICULARLY TO ONE HUNDRED TWENTY EIGHT (128) POLLING PLACES DURING THE CONDUCT OF MAY 10, 2010 FIRST AUTOMATED NATIONAL AND LOCAL ELECTION. ALL THESE EFFORTS WERE GEARED TO ACHIEVE LASTING PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT WHICH IS OUR UNIT'S MISSION.

LTC ANIANO B ORAP-ORAP JR INF (GSC) PA ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE UNIT AT BN HQS, BRGY MANDUG BUHANGIN DISTRICT, DAVAO CITY ON 05 JULY 2010, WITH AN TOTAL STRENGTH OF FOUR HUNDRED FOURTY EIGHT (448) COMPOSED OF TWENTY OFFICER (20) OFFICER AND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY EIGHT (428) ENLISTED PERSONNEL. AREA OF OPERATION COVERS THE SIX (6) DISTRICTS OF DAVAO CITY NAMELY: PAQUIBATO; EASTERN PORTION OF MARILOG; CALINAN; TUGBOK; BUHANGIN AND BUNAWAN DISTRICT. THE WHOLE CITY OF PANABO; BRGY MAGWAWA OF STO. TOMAS, BRGY TIBULAO AND BRGY MABUHAY OF CARMEN ALL OF DAVAO DEL NORTE. IN LINE WITH THE 10ID, PA CAMPAIGN PLAN AND IPSP BAYANIHAN, THIS UNIT TASKED TO CONDUCT PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT OUTREACH PROGRAM (PDOP) WITHIN 10ID AOR.

HQS & HQS SERVICE COMPANY COMPOSED OF SIXTEEN (16) OFFICER AND TWO HUNDRED THIRTY FOUR (234) ENLISTED PERSONNEL WITH A TOTAL OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (250) PERSONNEL. ON 14 SEPTEMBER 2010, ONE (1) PLATOON, HHSVCO OF THIS UNIT WAS PLACED OPCON TO 3RD SPECIAL FORCES BATTALION, SOCOM, PA AND CONDUCTED PDOP TRAINING AT HQS

3SF, BN AT BRGY SAN ISIDRO, TAGUM CITY AND SAID TRAINING WAS COMPLETELY COMPLETED ON 02 OCTOBER 2010. PBC 1 IS UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF LEONCIO PITAO AKA "PARAGO" WITH FORTY FIVE (45) MANPOWER AND ONE HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR (194) ASSORTED HIGH POWERED FIREARMS.

FOR 1ST SEMESTER 2014, PAQUIBATO DISTRICT BECAME THE NATIONAL PRIORITY AREA IN LINE WITH THE NUMEROUS VIOLENCE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY PBC 1 IN DAVAO CITY. FROM 2012 UP TO THIS REPORTING, SIXTY FOUR (64) NUMEROUS VIOLENCE INCIDENCE WERE RECORDED , AND SIGNIFICANT OF THESE INCIDENCE WERE REPORTED LAST SEPTEMBER 2012, WHEREIN PBC 1 INITIATED GRENADE THROWING DURING THE "CIRCUS SHOW" IN LINE WITH FIESTA CELEBRATION OF BARANGAY FATIMA, PDDC THAT RESULTED TO THE WOUNDING FORTY SEVEN (47) INNOCENT CIVILIANS. ALSO IN NOVEMBER 2012, FOUR (4) ENLISTED PERSONNEL ASSIGNED WITH 60TH INFANTRY BATTALION WERE AMBUSHED AND KILLED-IN- ACTION (KIA) AT VICINITY CINCO, BRGY MAPULA, PDDC. ANOTHER IN JUNE 2013, FIVE (5) ENLISTED PERSONNEL FROM SAME UNIT WERE ABDUCTED AT PUROK LUBAS,

PAQUIBATO PROPER, PDDC. AFTER MONTHS OF CAPTIVITY, THEY WERE RELEASED WITH THE NEGOTIATION MADE BY THE MAYOR OF DAVAO CITY. FURTHER, SEVERAL LANDMINE ATTACKS WERE ALSO INITIATED AGAINST GOVERNMENT FORCES PARTICULARLY OUR PDOP TEAMS OPERATING IN THE AREA WHILE SEVERAL CIVILIANS WERE THREATENED AND OTHERS WERE LIQUIDATED BY PBC1 WITH THE INSTRUCTION OF LOCAL PARTY BRANCH LEADER OF BEING SUSPECTED AS MILITARY INFORMANTS.

STARTING 3RD QUARTER 2012 UP TO 2013, AND WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF BATTALION IMPLAN "PILAK I", THIS UNIT CONDUCTED PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT OUTREACH PROGRAM ACTIVITIES IN ADDRESSING THE THREATS BEING POSED BY PBC 1 AND FURTHER IMMERSSED TO BARANGAY PROPER OF PAQUIBATO DISTRICT. HOWEVER, IT FAILED TO IDENTIFY MEMBERS OF UNDERGROUND MASS ORGANIZATION BECAUSE THE CENTER OF GRAVITY OF CNN MASS BASE WERE ESTABLISHED AND LOCATED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF ADJACENT BARANGAYS. IN ORDER TO ADDRESS THE IDENTIFIED OPERATIONAL GAP, SWARMING DEPLOYMENT OF PDOP TEAMS UP TO SITIO LEVEL WAS VIGOROUSLY IMPLEMENTED ON 21 FEBRUARY 2014 WITH THE AUGMENTATION OF TWO (2) COMPANIES OF 60TH INFANTRY BATTALION AND ONE (1) COMPANY FROM 84TH INFANTRY BATTALION TASKED TO DISMANTLE THE OPP OF CNN IN THE AREA.

IN 21 FEBRUARY 2014, 69TH INFANTRY BATTALION AS PART OF THE JOINT TASK GROUP PAQUIBATO CONDUCTED COMBAT CLEARING OPERATIONS AGAINST THE ELEMENTS OF PBC 1, AFTER WHICH, WE IMMEDIATELY DEPLOYED PDOP TEAMS TO TWENTY SEVEN (27) SITIOS WITHIN THE NINE (9) BARANGAYS OF PAQUIBATO DISTRICT, DAVAO CITY. WHEN TROOPS OCCUPIED THEIR RESPECTIVE AREAS, THEY CONDUCTED NEEDS ASSESSMENT SURVEY (NAS) AND "KAMAY, KAWAY, NGITI, BATI" (KKNB) TO LOCAL POPULACE TO WIN THEIR THRUST AND CONFIDENCE TOWARDS THE GOVERNMENT. DURING THE CONDUCT OF SURVEY, TROOPS WERE ABLE TO FOUND OUT THE ISSUES BEING EXPLOITED BY CNN TOWARDS THE LOCAL POPULACE. AMONG THESE LOCAL ISSUES SUCH AS MINING EXPLORATION WHERE OUR PDOP TEAMS WERE BEING ACCUSED AS ADVANCE ELEMENTS TO SECURE MINING COMPANY, PROGRAM OF LAND DISTRIBUTION OF DEPARTMENT OF AGRARIAN REFORM WAS BOGUS BECAUSE THE BENEFICIARIES WERE REQUIRED TO PAY THE ANNUAL DUES BEFORE THEY CAN ACQUIRE/POSSESS THE CERTIFICATE OF LAND TITLE. THEY ALSO

EXPLOITED THE CADT OF THE INDIGENOUS PEOPLE WHEREIN THEY ACCUSED IP COMMUNITY SHALL GRAB THE LAND WHICH WERE ALREADY OWNED AND TILT BY THE NON-LUMAD POPULACE. LASTLY, THE CNN EXPLOITED THE HIGH INPUTS PRODUCTS AND LOW OUTPUT PRODUCTS THAT ONLY THE COMPRADORS WILL CONTINUE TO BE RICH AND THE PEASANTS WILL ALWAYS BE THE POOR, AND THE ONLY SOLUTION TO THIS SITUATION IS THROUGH ARMED STRUGGLE. WHILE FOR THE SECONDARY ISSUES, THE MOST COMMON WERE THE FARM TO MARKET ROAD, WATER SYSTEM, MEDICAL FACILITIES, INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS, AND ELECTRICITY.

PPDOP TEAMS DEPLOYED IN BARANGAYS AND SITIOS/PUROKS WERE ABLE TO COUNTER SAID ISSUES BY CONDUCTING KKNB AS PART OF THE PDTS DAILY ACTIVITIES. THE TROOPS ALSO CONDUCTED SITIO/PUROK LEVEL PULONG-PULONG IN ORDER TO EDUCATE THE POPULACE ON HOW THEY WERE DECEIVED BY THE CNN. THROUGH SAID PULONG-PULONG, THE TROOPS WERE ALSO ABLE TO COUNTER THE PROPAGANDA USED BY THE CNN WITH THE HELP OF THE TECHNICAL SUPPORT GROUP FROM THE EASTERN MINDANAO COMMAND. THEY ALSO CONDUCTED INTERVIEW/TACTICAL INTERROGATION TO THE TARGET PERSONALITIES IN THEIR RESPECTIVE SITIO'S/PUROKS AS WELL AS BRGY LEVEL THAT LEADS TO THE UNEARTHING OF POLITICO-MILITARY STRUCTURE OF THE ENEMY.

AT THE BARANGAY LEVEL, PDOP TEAM CONDUCTED BRGY FUNCTIONARIES FORUM ATTENDED BY BARANGAY COUNCIL, SITIO LEADERS AND OTHER PEOPLE ORGANIZATION AND GRAND PULONG-PULONG AT THE BARANGAY AND SITIO LEVEL WITH THE SUPPORT OF THE TECHNICAL SUPPORT GROUP FROM THE EASTERN MINDANAO COMMAND THAT HASTENS THE DISMANTLING OF THE POLITICO-MILITARY STRUCTURE AND IN THE NEUTRALIZATION OF ITS MEMBERS.

PDOP TEAM HAVE ALSO COORDINATED TO LGUS, LGAS, NGOS AND OTHER CONCERNED AGENCIES TO FACILITATE AND ADDRESSED THE ISSUES AND NEEDS LIKE FMR, WATER SYSTEM, SCHOOL BUILDINGS, LIVELIHOOD, AND MEDICAL SERVICES IN PAQUIBATO DISTRICT. REGULAR CONDUCT OF FACE TO FACE DIALOGUES OF PDOP TEAMS RESULTED TO THE SURRENDERED OF TWENTY FOUR (24) ACTIVE MEMBERS OF PBC1, NEUTRALIZED FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY SEVEN (437) UGMO MEMBERS, CO-OPTED ELEVEN (11) ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS FARMERS, WOMEN YOUTH AND

COOPERATIVES AND RECRUITED TWO HUNDRED SIXTY TWO (262) INFORMANTS.

FURTHER THE UNIT INITIATED FOURTEEN (14) BATTALION OPERATIONS, SEVEN (7) COMPANY OPERATIONS, SIXTY NINE (69) PLATOON OPERATIONS AND TWO THOUSAND SEVENTY TWO (2,072) SMALL UNIT OPERATIONS THAT RESULTED TO SIX (6) ENGAGEMENTS AGAINST THE BASIL PLATOON OF PBC1, SMRC AND RECOVERY OF THREE (3) LANDMINE WITH SIX HUNDRED TWENTY (620) ELECTRICAL WIRE, THREE (3) ROUNDS OF M203 LIVE AMMO, BLACK POWDER, ONE (1) MAGAZINE SPRING, ONE (1) CHARGING HANDLE AND ONE (1) BOLT ASSEMBLE OF M16 RIFLE, EMPTY SHELLS OF M14, M16, M60 WITH LINKED AND LINKED OF K3 NINE (9) PCS EMPTY CARTON OF 5.56 MM M193 BALL (30 RND) GOV'T ARSENAL DND WITH THE FOLLOWING LOT NUMBERS: (LOT CDA 10-16, LOT CDA 08-12, LOT CDA 10-24, THREE (3) LOT CDA 10-20, LOT CDA W/O NUMBER, GA 556110 LOT CAPD M-12-01 AND GA 556100 LOT CAPD A-11-13), TWO (2) CNN FLAGS (BHB AND NDF FLAG), BACK PACK, FIFTEEN (15) HAMMOCKS, FIFTEEN (15) PONCHO SUBVERSIVE DOCUMENTS AND OTHER PERSONAL BELONGINGS SIXTEEN (16) DISCOVERY OF ENEMY CAMP. AS PER REVELATION OF DATU TONY INGAY, A FORMER REBEL THE EXHUMED THREE (3) MALE SKELETAL WERE IDENTIFIED AS @ LOLONG, @ POGI AND @ ALLAN AND ONE (1) UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE WHO WAS THE WIFE OF @ ALLAN UNDER @JARIS (TN: ROBERTO COMENADOR) OF GF 56, SRC 5, SMRC. SAID MEMBERS WERE KILLED BY THEIR FELLOW NPA ON ALLEGATIONS THAT THEY WERE MILITARY AGENTS. THIRTY ONE (31) NPAS MEMBERS SURRENDERED.

IN COMMUNITY ORGANIZING, THE POLICE SA BARANGAY FROM THE REGIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY BATTALION 11 WERE AUGMENTED TO THIS UNIT AND THEY WERE DEPLOYED IN THE BARANGAY PROPER TO HAVE RECRUITED AND CONDUCTED BARANGAY PEACEKEEPING ACTION TEAM (BPATS) TRAINING FOR THE DURATION OF THREE (3) DAYS. SAID TRAINING FOCUSED ON THE LAW ENFORCEMENT, INTERNAL SECURITY OPERATIONS, DISASTER MITIGATION, AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION. PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT TEAMS (PDTS) ALSO RECRUITED AND CONDUCTED TRAINING TO ORGANIZED PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT VOLUNTEERS (PDVS) WITH A TOTAL OF THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT (3,978) MEMBERS. SAID TRAINING FOCUSES ON THE LIVELIHOOD OF THE POPULACE. THE TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (TESDA) CONDUCTED COMMUNITY TECHNOLOGY-BASED TRAINING ON THE DIFFERENT BARANGAY OF PAQUIBATO DISTRICT THROUGH THE EFFORT OF STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT BY THIS UNIT. SAID TRAINING FOCUSES ON THE SIX (6) TRADE AREAS SPECIFICALLY ON FOOD PROCESSING, WELDING, MOTORCYCLE AND SMALL ENGINE SERVICING, COMPUTER HARDWARE SERVICING, ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE, AND PLUMBING AND MASONRY. THE DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY ALSO CONDUCTED TECHNOLOGY-DEMONSTRATION IN BANANA KETCHUP MAKING, DISHWASHING

SOAP MAKING, BURGER PATTIES PROCESSING, AND SIOMAI PROCESSING. SAID LIVELIHOOD TRAININGS SOMEHOW CONTRIBUTED IN REDUCING UNEMPLOYMENT IN THE AREA OF OPERATIONS AND ALLEVIATING THE LIVES OF THE BENEFICIARIES. YOUTH LEADERSHIP SUMMIT WAS ALSO CONDUCTED BY THIS UNIT AS PART OF ORGANIZING THE YOUTH OF PAQUIBATO DISTRICT, DAVAO CITY.

SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES WERE ALSO CONDUCTED BY THIS UNIT IN ORDER TO DISMANTLE THE POLITICO-MILITARY STRUCTURE OF THE ENEMY. ONE OF THESE IS THE THREE (3) DAYS LIVE-IN SEMINAR THAT WAS CONDUCTED LAST 15 TO 17 MAY 2014 AT BARANGAY PAQUIBATO PROPER. THE PRIMARY ATTENDEES OF THIS SEMINAR WERE THE MEMBERS OF THE "LOCAL PARTY BRANCH" OF THE ENEMY'S UNDERGROUND MASS ORGANIZATION WITH A TOTAL OF FOUR HUNDRED NINETY EIGHT (498) PARTICIPANTS. SAID ACTIVITY WAS CULMINATED WITH A PEACE RALLY PARTICIPATED BY MORE OR LESS THREE THOUSAND (3,000) CONCERNED CITIZENS FROM THE DIFFERENT BARANGAYS OF PAQUIBATO DISTRICT, DAVAO CITY. THIS ACTIVITY WAS HIGHLIGHTED BY BURNING OF CNN FLAG BY THE PARTICIPANTS AND RELEASING OF WHITE DOVES BY NO LESS THAN THE COMMANDER, EASTERN MINDANAO COMMAND, LTGEN RICARDO RAINIER G CRUZ III, AFP. THE COMMANDER, 10TH INFANTRY DIVISION MGEN ARIEL B BERNARDO, AFP WAS ALSO PRESENT IN THE ACTIVITY.

FURTHERMORE, DIFFERENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES OF THE GOVERNMENT TOGETHER WITH THE NON-GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATIONS/AGENCIES AND LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVES OF DAVAO CITY WITH THE ASSOCIATION OF REGIONAL EXECUTIVES AND NATIONAL AGENCIES (ARENA XI) CONDUCTED "SERBISYO CARAVAN" DURING THE "UNITY FOR PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT" FROM 09 TO 12 JUNE 2014 IN BRGY PAQUIBATO PROPER, PAQUIBATO DISTRICT, DAVAO CITY.
