Symbol and Meaning

1. Shield – denotes protector of the people.
2. Sun – symbolizes liberty.
3. Rice paddies – denotes that Battalion as a unit of the Division is situated right at the heart of the rice granary of the Philippines.
4. Mount Arayat – the most dominant feature in Central Luzon.

UNIT HISTORY

THIS UNIT TRACED ITS ORIGIN FROM THE HQ AND HQ SERVICE COMPANY WHICH ORGANOZED ON 16 FEBRUARY 1987 AS AN ORGANIC UNIT OF THE ACTIVATED 3RD INFANTRY BRIGADE (SEPARATE) PHIIPPINE ARMY STATIONED AT CAMP SERVILLANO AQUINO, TARLAC WITH COLONEL GUILLERMO G FLORES PA AS THE FIRST COMMANDER. ON 01 AUGUST 1988, SAID UNIT WAS UPGRADED TO HQ AND HQ SVC BN PURSUANT TO GENERAL ORDERS NR 6, HQ 7ID, PA DATED 15 AUGUST 1988.

A. MISSION

TO PROVIDE ADMINISTRATIVE, LIMITED ENGINEERING, BAND AND FIRE FIGHTING SERVICES AND MILITARY POLICE OPERATION IN ORDER TO SUPPORT 7ID MISSION.

B. FUNCTIONS:

- a. PROVIDE SECURITY OF FORT MAGSAYSAY CANTONMENT AREA.
- b. PROVIDED FOOD SERVICES, INDUSTRIAL, ORGANIZATIONAL AND FINANCIAL SERVICES TO ITS ORGANIC TROOPS AND CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES.
- c. PROVIDE TROOPS FOR DISASTER/CALAMITY ASSISTANCE DUTIES AMD OTHER COMMAND DIRECTED ACTIVITIES.
- d. PROVIDE OTHER SECURITY SERVICES WITHIN FORT MAGSAYSAY TO INCLUDE VIP's VISITING THE COMMAND.
- e. MAINTENANCE OF BUILDIN G FACILITIES AND GROUNDS FACILITIES INSIDE FORT MAGSAYSAY.
