On 16 August 1988 the Service Support Company was upgraded to Service Support Battalion pursuant to General Order Nr 7, HQS 7<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, Philippine Army dated 17 February 1988. The Service Support Battalion was organized into Five (5) Companies, Headquarters Service Company, Transportation Company, Maintenance Company, Supply and Service Company and the Forward Support Medical Company.

**SSBn**

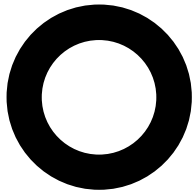
Acronym for Service Support Battalion

Color- Gold means high state of wellness



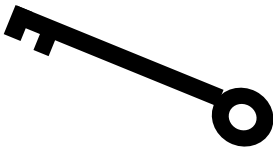
Circular Ring – represent wheel that connotes Transportation Company , its mission is to give transportation services
